**The following were discussed: -**

- 1) **B/15/01371 – 18 Stone Street** – Proposal to remove multiple outbuildings, erect extensions, annexe and three bay cartlodge. **No Objections.** D Waspe and A Sargeant had declared interests in this application and left the room whilst it was being discussed.
- 2) **B/15/01413 - Little Field, Cox Hill** - Proposed felling of ornamental crabapple tree, reduce height of whitebeam and remove the lower limbs of silver birch. **No Objections.**
- 3) **B/15/01407 - 24 Ellis Street** - Proposal to lift first branches of Scotts Pine to allow light to prevent damage to the wall and prevent the tree getting too dominant. **No Objections.**
